Volunteer Guidelines

1. Your main purpose is to **HELP** the **TEACHER!** You will be assigned a teacher/class on the first day of camp. You will remain in that class for the **entire week**.
 2. Report in the morning to the check-in area at the front door. On Monday, June 19 please arrive at 8:30 am to assist with check-in and classroom set up.
 3. Lead students to cafeteria for snack and lunch breaks.
 4. Remain with students during these breaks.
 5. Lead students to class after breaks.
 6. Be a positive example to the students, faculty, and other volunteers.
 7. If you feel you could be more of an assistant, talk to the teacher to see if there are more responsibilities you could perform.

8. Turn off cell phone during class instruction - you should be too busy helping the teacher and students to use your cell phone at this time.
 9. Cell phone may be turned on and used during **break times ONLY**.
