Over 100 children attend our arts camp each year to discover their artistic talents through professional instruction and hands on experience!



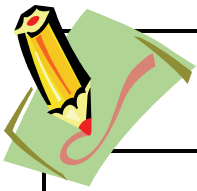

GENERAL CAMP INFORMATION

- Students entering grades 3-8 in Fall 2018 are eligible to register.
- Students are grouped by age into small sized classes limited to 14 campers with one teacher and 1-2 student assistants.
- Campers will take the same 3 art workshops each day. They will be assigned first come-first serve. They should select 5 workshops in order of preference.
- Workshops are 90 minutes long. There will be a break between each workshop.
- Campers bring their own lunch and snacks each day.
- Camp concludes with an exhibit of campers' work and performances on the last day of camp (**Thursday, June 21**) for parents, friends, and family.
- Tuition covers all art supplies, instruction, and a camp T-shirt.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: CAMPERS WISHING TO BE PLACED IN WORKSHOPS WITH THEIR FRIENDS **MUST** SEND REGISTRATION FORMS AT THE SAME TIME!

- Advance registration is required. Registration deadline: June 8, 2019. Fees must be paid in full at the time of Registration.
- Workshops are subject to minimum and maximum enrollment and are filled first-come, first-served.
- Confirmation letter with final workshop selections will be mailed to you no later than June 11th.

Discounts and financial assistance:

- Membership must be current on the first day of camp to receive member rate.

- WCAC members receive 10% discount on registration fee only. Discounts don't apply to transportation fee.

Procedure for receiving and releasing children:

- Neither staff nor instructors are responsible for camp attendees before or after the scheduled camp time. Parents are responsible for signing their child out each day.
- A late fee of \$10.00 for each 15 minute period will be charged at the time of pick up.
- **ADVANCED WRITTEN NOTICE** is required if someone other than the person listed on the application is to pick up your child.
- If a child lives within walking distance and is allowed to walk home, written confirmation must be provided and signed by a parent/guardian.
