

CALL FOR ENTRIES: COMPETITION GUIDELINES

The Worcester County Arts Council invites all interested artists to participate in a juried art competition and exhibit to be presented during the month of April at the WCAC Gallery located at 6 Jefferson Street in Berlin. The exhibition is open to all artists (18 years old and older), professional or amateur with work in all media. All work must be original and completed within the last three years. All entries will be juried in for the inclusion in the competition by local artist, Peggy Warfield.

Monetary prizes will be awarded for first, second, and third place at 5:30 pm during the Second Friday Arts Stroll reception to be held on April 13 from 5 - 8 pm.

ARTISTS WILL BE NOTIFIED BY EMAIL OF THEIR ENTRIES ACCEPTANCE FOR THE COMPETITION ONCE IT IS REVIEWED BY THE JUROR/JUDGE OF THE SHOW.

THEME: MY FAVORITE SUBJECT

ELIGIBILITY:

The exhibition is open to all artists, professional or amateur with work in all media. All work must be original and completed within the last three years. Copies will not be accepted. The Arts Council reserves the right to reject any work not suitable for this exhibit. Entry fees will not be returned.

ENTRY FEES:

- Maximum of two entries
- \$10.00 for members, for each entry
- \$15.00 for non-members for each entry
- Entry fees are non-refundable
- Checks payable to WCAC

ENTRIES:

All entries (2-D and 3-D) are eligible and must be ready for display. All 2-D work must be ready for hanging with sturdy wire (wire taped at ends). Entries may not be larger than 30"x36" including frame.

AWARDS:

Awards will be announced at 5:30 pm at the Opening Reception to be held on April 13 from 5:00 - 8:00 pm.

The following awards will be given:

- * First Place \$ 100
- * Second Place \$ 75
- * Third Place \$ 50

Honorable Mention: Three (non-monetary) Awards.

DELIVERY /PICK-UP:

Delivery of artwork: March 29 - March 30: 11:00 - 3:00

Pick-up of artwork: May 1 - 2. Hours: 11:00 - 3:00

WCAC is not responsible for artwork remaining after pick-up dates.

LIABILITY:

WCAC will not be responsible for damage or loss whatever the cause.

SALE OF ARTWORK:

At least one of the entries must be for sale. WCAC retains a 25% commission on all works sold.

All artwork will remain in the exhibition for the duration of the exhibit.

IDENTIFICATION AND LABELING OF ENTRIES:

Each artwork will need two 3x5" cards. Each card needs the following information:

Artist's name, title of artwork, medium, and price (or NFS). Secure one card to the back.

Loosely tape one card to the front of each artwork.
