

## Supply List for Impressionistic Oil Painting

1. Two, primed, stretched canvas (on wooden stretchers) at least 16" x 20" or 12" x 16"  
*(We cannot use canvas glued to a stiff board for this style of painting.)*
2. Palette—12" x 16" is desired size. (A disposable, waxed paper pad *for oil paints* is best.)
3. Palette knife
4. Brushes (#2 or #6 *natural hog bristle* "filbert")  
*(Note: Sable/soft bristle brushes will not work with this technique.)*
5. Oil Paints  
*Suggested beginning colors:*
  - a. Cadmium Red *Light*
  - b. French Ultramarine Blue
  - c. Cerulean Blue (or Cobalt Blue)
  - d. Permanent Rose
  - e. White (Large size)
  - f. Cadmium Yellow *Light*
  - g. Viridian Green
  - h. Sap Green
  - i. Yellow Ochre
  - j. Burnt Sienna

*(Please note that water-soluble oil paints can be used for this class.  
However, you can't mix the water-soluble oil paints with the regular oil paints.)*
6. HB or 2-B pencil
7. Kneaded eraser
8. Cloth rags and/or paper towels (for clean up)
9. Odorless Turpenoid (*NOT turpentine or paint thinner because of the fumes!*)  
*Note: If you are using water-soluble oils, you don't have to buy this Turpenoid. You will use water to clean your brushes.*
10. Small jar with lid (to store used turpenoid)
11. Tuna-sized can (to hold turpenoid on palette)
12. Floor or table easel (WCAC provides a few of these in their classroom.)

**Note:** In class, students will be working from their *personal* photos. (*We can't use photos from printed calendars, newspapers or magazine photos.*) **Please bring at least three photos that inspire you to the very first class, and we will choose one for you to paint. An 8"x 10" photo is best so that you can see detail.**
